

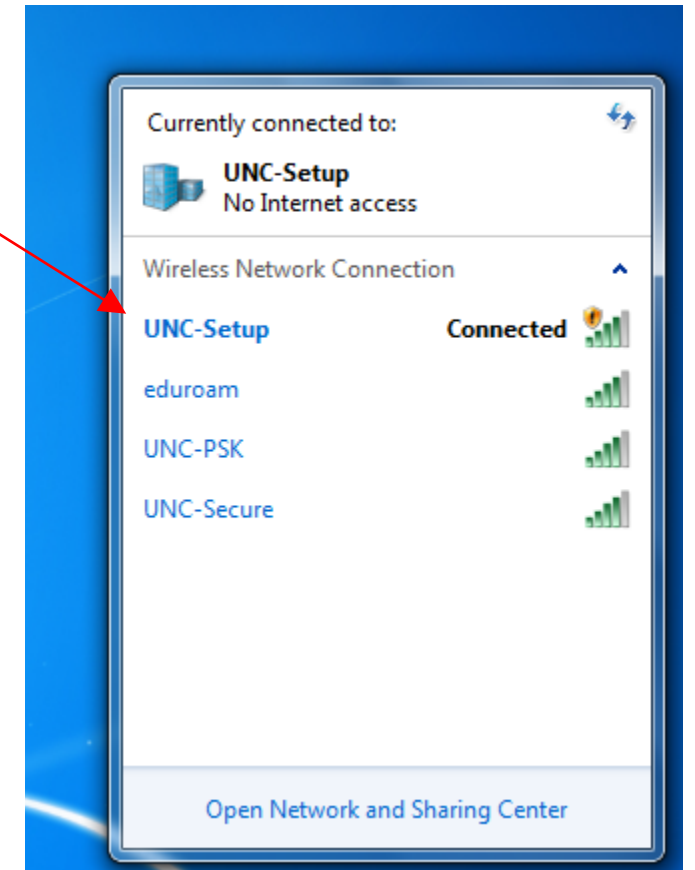
Eduroam Configuration for Windows

IT Support

Step 1:

- Connect to the *UNC-Setup* wireless network.



Step 2:

- Once connected to the *UNC-Setup* network, the eduroam Wireless Configuration Portal should automatically launch in a browser window.
- If it does not, open a browser window and go to wifi.unc.edu



Step 3:

- Select the *Click here to configure* button to continue with the configuration.




Step 4:

- The UNC Wireless Network Configuration Utility will then detect your system information.
- Click *JoinNow* to begin configuration.



Step 5:

- A configuration EXE file should begin downloading.
- After the EXE file is finished downloading, click on the file to run the EXE program.

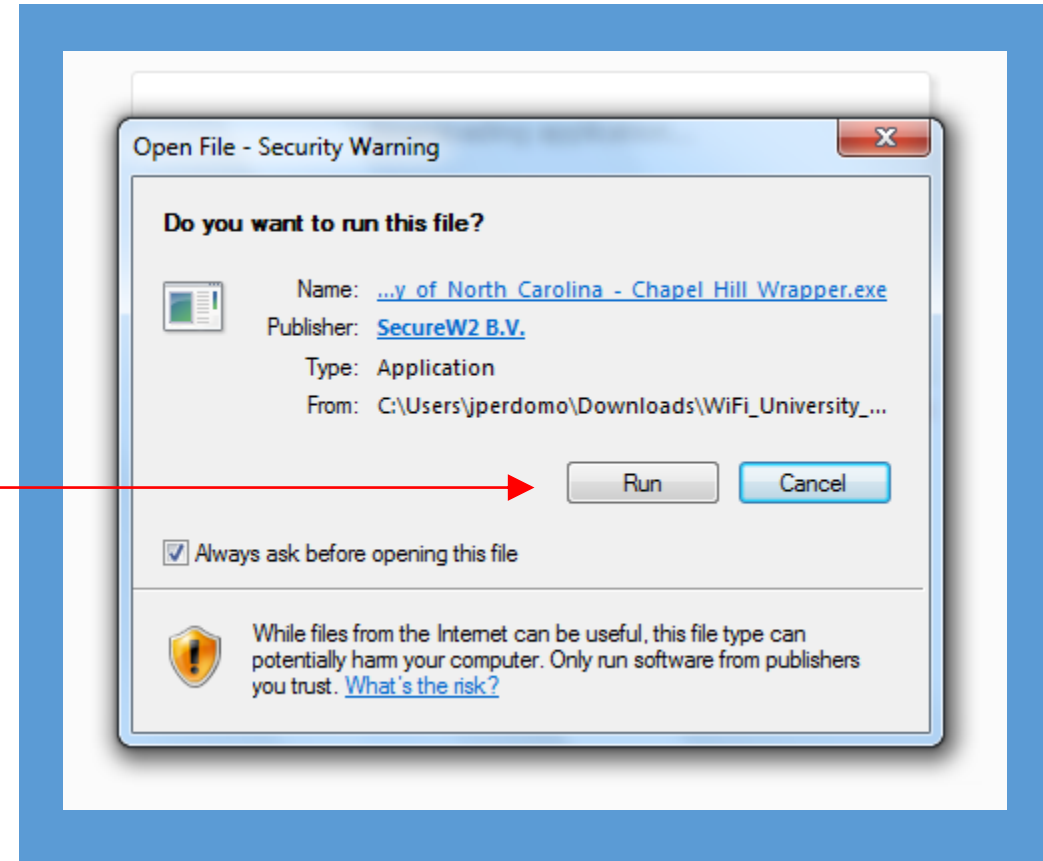
