

## Targeted RFA for Cancer Outcomes Research

Through this RFA, we are particularly interested in proposals that address the following high-priority outcomes research areas, and encourage inter-disciplinary collaboration (including collaboration between researchers, health care administrators, quality officers/staff, and/or clinicians):

- Research that addresses improvement of quality of care delivery in the UNC Cancer Hospital and/or UNC Healthcare system.
- Research that advances measurement or improvement of quality in community cancer care delivery in the state of North Carolina, which may include pilot work developing networks of practices in North Carolina towards assessing quality.
- Research using artificial intelligence to analyze clinical outcomes data towards creating decision support algorithms.
- Research studying implementation of patient-reported outcomes in clinical care.

Proposals may be submitted under either the Tier 1 Pilot Study or the Tier 2 Stimulus Award mechanism, and will be reviewed by a study section made up of population science faculty and leadership.
