

LCCC Henningsen User Guide

Display the Room's PC

Turn the projector on by pressing the "POWER ON" button on the wall-mounted Crestron control panel.



Once the projector is on, it will display the room's PC. If the PC does not display on the screen, click the mouse or tap the keyboard to wake it up.

If the PC still does not display, it is likely powered off. Press the power button on the PC (mounted under the table) to turn it back on. The PC will then log in automatically.

Note: A USB extension cable is available on the table for connecting a USB device (flash drive) to the room PC.

When you are finished, simply press the POWER OFF button on the Crestron control panel. Please **DO NOT** shut down the computer.

Display a Laptop

Make sure the projector is powered on. Find the appropriate connector on the table for your laptop and plug it in.



Once your laptop is properly connected, it should automatically display on the screen.


If your laptop does not display, please make sure the cable is fully inserted into the laptop. It may also help to disconnect the cable and re-insert it.

When you are finished, simply press the POWER OFF button on the Crestron control panel.

Web-Conferencing (Webex, Zoom, Skype, etc.)

Start or join your meeting using the room's PC. The room's camera and microphone are not accessible with a laptop.

When prompted by the conferencing software (e.g. Webex), select "ClearSHOT USB" for the Video Device, and "Echo Cancelling Speakerphone (Jabra)" for the Audio Device.



To adjust the camera shot, use the Pan, Tilt and Zoom buttons on the "Vaddio" remote control (located in the credenza drawer).



Controlling Audio in the Room

Use the volume controls on the Crestron control panel to raise, lower, or mute the wall-mounted speakers. You may also need to adjust the volume on the PC or laptop.
