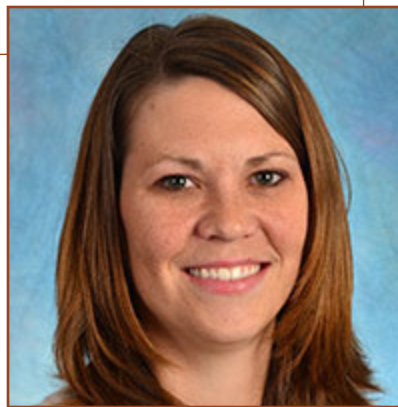

## Caring for the Patient with a GI Cancer
