Dr. Joanna Watson is the Chief of the Tumor Metastasis Branch of the Division of Cancer Biology (DCB) at the NCI. After a postdoctoral fellowship at UNC, she worked as a Senior Editor at JNCI, and then joined the NIH in 2005, first as a Scientific Review Officer in the Center for Scientific Review and then as a Program Director with the NCI. She leads several large programs including Metastasis Research Network and the Oncology Models Forum within DCB, oversees a diverse grant portfolio across multiple mechanisms including R01, R35, R37, P01 and U01, and is responsible for the annual DCB New Grantee Workshop, which helps ease demystify the NIH and NCI grants processes for investigators who have just transitioned into their first academic position or just received their first substantive award.
